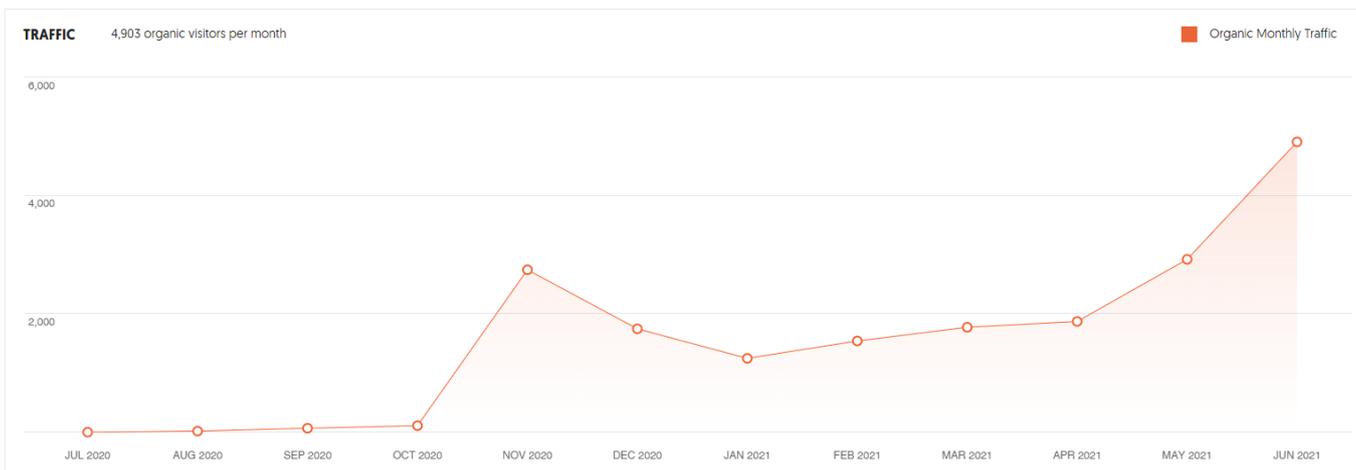

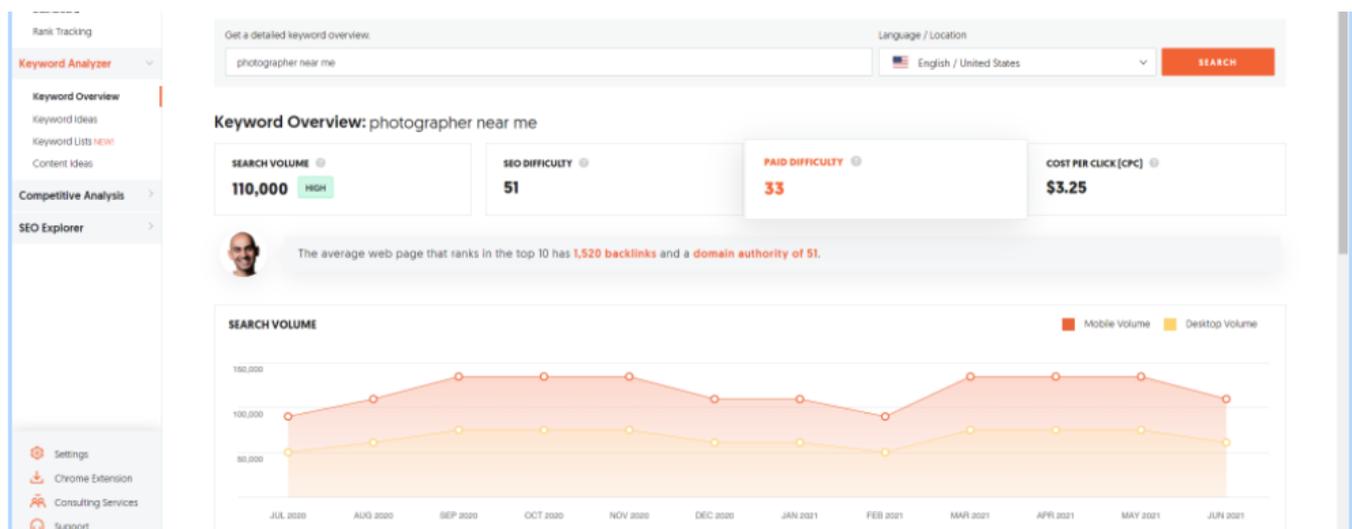

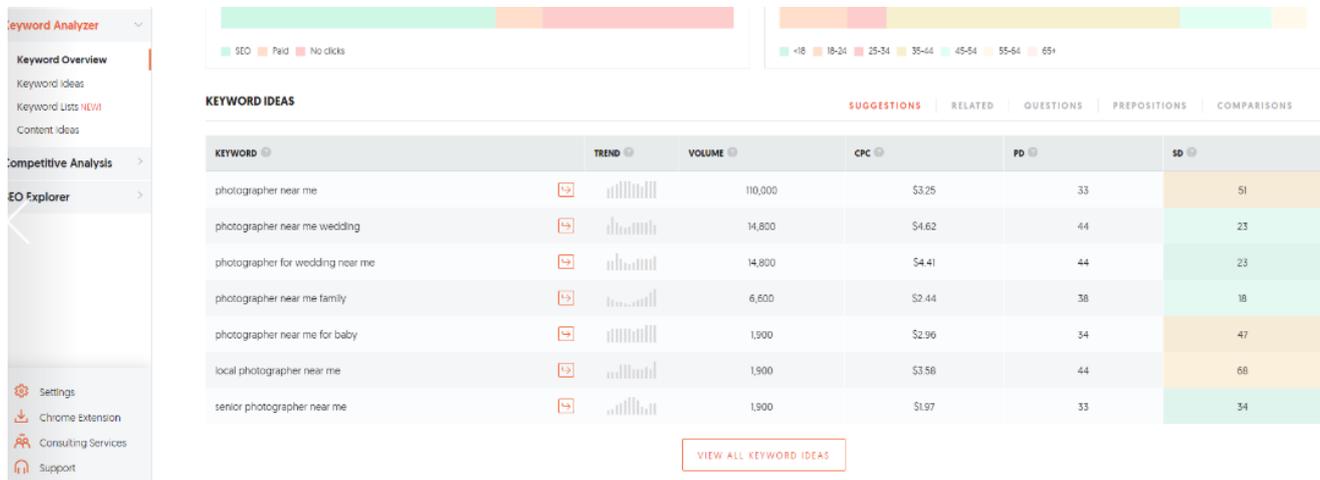

SEO Difficulty and SERP Analysis
