- Citizenship of: Angola, Botswana, Comoros, Lesotho, Malawi, Madagascar, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Seychelles, South Africa, Swaziland, Zambia or Zimbabwe.
- Ability to commit to a seven-weeks online course
- English language proficiency

- Young leaders with disabilities

- Women
- People who are HIV positive or who are living with AIDS • Individuals that represent and advocate for the rights of LGBTIQ communities across the region
